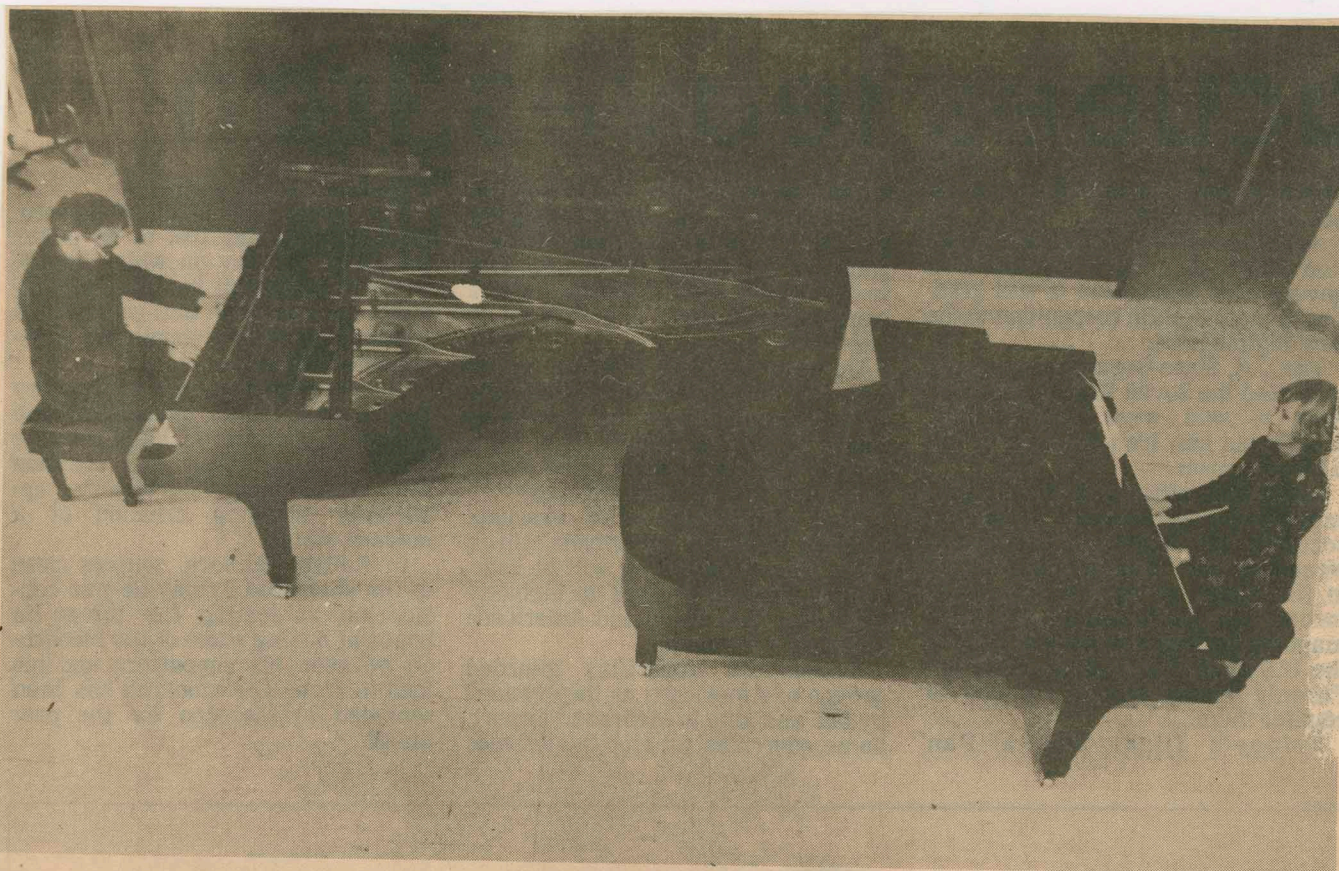

# Concert dedicates gift pianos

A dedicatory concert will be performed at 3 p.m. Sunday in McCray Auditorium featuring the new Kawai Recital Grand and Kawai Concert Grand pianos donated to Pittsburg State University by Mrs. Frances Baxter.

PSU faculty and students displaying the instruments' variety and capabilities will include John MacKay, Jerry Ludiker, David Emerson, Robert Ensor, Lois Nichols and Charlotte Carter.

Assisting the pianists will be Mary Elliott James, violinist; Logan Jones, violist; Carolann Martin and Heather Williams, cellists; Carol Sue Maxwell, soprano; Linda Beckman, alto; William Vance, tenor; Robert Smith, bass; Mark Warren, horn; and Larry Bridges, flute.

The program will include "Piano Quartet in G Minor" by Mozart; "Quartet Op. 47 for Piano, Violin, Viola and Cello," Schumann; "Suite Modale" by Bloch; "Liebeslieder Walzer" by Brahms; "Scherzo Op.

16 No. 2" by Mendelssohn; "Waltz in A Flute Major" by Chopin; and "Fantasie-Impromptu" and "Double Concerto in C Minor," both by J.S. Bach.

In commemoration of Mrs. Baxter's gift to PSU, brass plaques are being placed on both pianos in her name. Following the concert, a public reception will be held for Mrs. Baxter in the McCray lobby.
